### HEALTH AND SAFETY MESSAGE

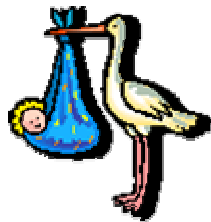


We need to remind our children that in the colder weather we need to take care of ourselves.
